

## GONE WITH THE WIND

### A 40 Bar Jig for Three Couples in a Four Couple Longwise Set

Bars

- 01 – 08
- \* 1-2 1<sup>st</sup> couple set to each other
  - \* 3-4 1<sup>st</sup> couple cast off one place, 2<sup>nd</sup> couple move up.
  - \* 5-6 1<sup>st</sup> couple set to each other
  - \* 7-8 1<sup>st</sup> couple cast off one place, 3<sup>rd</sup> couple move up.
- 09 – 16
- \* 9-12 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> couples dance four hands round
  - \* 13-14 1<sup>st</sup> lady with 3<sup>rd</sup> lady, 1<sup>st</sup> man with 3<sup>rd</sup> man turn right hands to: 3<sup>rd</sup> couple in 3<sup>rd</sup> place and 1<sup>st</sup> couple back to back in the middle, facing their own lines.
  - \* 15-16 All set in double triangle positions
- 17 – 24
- \* 17-20 1<sup>st</sup> couple dance right about round each other to change places while 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> couples cross; they all set in double triangle positions
  - \* 21-22 all set advancing, pulling right shoulder back, finishing: 1<sup>st</sup> couple in 2<sup>nd</sup> place opposite lines, couples 2 & 3 back to back in the middle.
  - \* 23-24 all set giving hands in inverted triangle positions. Hands are released at the beginning of bar 24, couples 2&3 finishing shoulder to shoulder, facing up and down.
- 25 – 32
- \* 25-28 1<sup>st</sup> couple petronella as 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> couples petronella in tandem and all set. First couple finish in the middle of the dance, 1<sup>st</sup> man in first place facing down, 1<sup>st</sup> lady in 3<sup>rd</sup> place facing up, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> couples facing across the dance.
  - \* 29-30 1<sup>st</sup> couple set, while 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> ladies, and 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> man, cross right hand
  - \* 31-32 All chase clockwise to: couples 3, 1, 2 on opposite sides
- 33 – 40
- 1<sup>st</sup> woman with 3<sup>rd</sup> couple & 1<sup>st</sup> man with 2<sup>nd</sup> couple dance half a right shoulder reel of 3 across the dance, then 1<sup>st</sup> lady with 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> ladies and 1<sup>st</sup> man with 3<sup>rd</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> man dance half a left shoulder reel of 3 on their own lines.

The order is now: 2, 1, 3.

Repeat, having passed a couple.

Note: this dance was devised in 2017 by Christiane Orgeret, as a happy memory of her 30 years at the head of the RSCDS Lyon group, then Branch - spot the number 30 in the first 12 bars, and feel the wind in the last 12!
